An Update from Dr. Standish

May 5, 2010

Greetings from Bastyr University.

In the first 14 months since the Bastyr Integrated Oncology Research Center (BIORC) opened we have treated 148 cancer patients.

Approximately 1/3 of these patients are breast cancer patients at all stages (I-IV). In January 2010 we began doing intravenous therapy for some of our patients who need IV nutrition and/or IV ascorbic acid therapy.

We received a high priority score from the NIH reviewers for performing a BIORC matched controlled prospective outcomes study of women with breast cancer who receive integrated oncology plus standard oncology treatments compared to women of similar stage and age who receive only standard of care. This study, if funded, will be done in partnership with Dr. Robyn Andersen at Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center.

With the funding from Cleavage Creek in this year we purchased an electrical exam table for patients who are fragile and weak. Patients and docs love it.

BIORC has been so successful that we already need more exam and treatment rooms.
